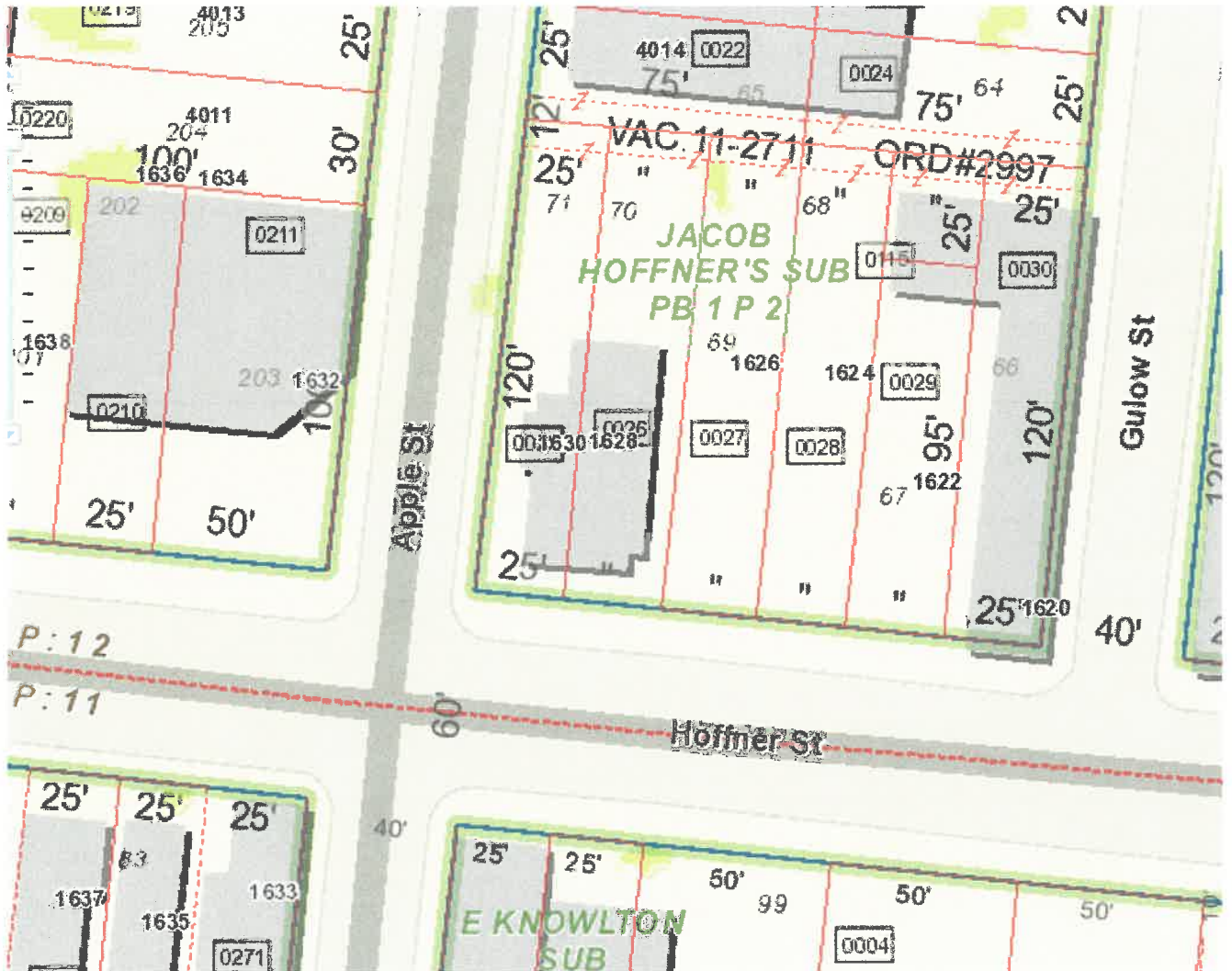

Businesses are listed by proximity to the property to be developed. Due to the fact this property comes with a parking lot I have listed most of the businesses of the lower area of our business district. With the growth we have experienced & the potential growth of the 4000 block of Hamilton Avenue & surrounding area this added parking would be a valuable asset to this area.

Job Impact

Job impact numbers are based on the average occupancy of employees in comparable buildings in the surrounding area. This represents projected permanent jobs housed within the redeveloped building. This does not include the additional employment and infrastructure resulting from the redevelopment process which would create significant shorter term employment and commerce in the construction and related local trades, or the additional commerce generated from the activities of new business that would be located there long term.

The adjacent parking lot will also provide a supporting infrastructure to the surrounding area businesses.

Budget

This budget is based on estimations from executive members of the NBA. We are comprised of architects & property owners, who have had experience with renovating properties through this grant process.
