1. Can you please provide a phone number needed by the courier to organize the express delivery of the proposal? **513-352-3209 or 531-352-4507**
2. Since the request is for a web-based, mobile friendly tool, we are not proposing to subcontract any of the work locally. This will then exclude us from the criteria (4), "Economic Inclusion Goal". **The Economic Inclusion Goal has been waived for this RFP; however, each bidder is strongly encouraged to make efforts in this area and there are scoring opportunities for Economic Inclusion.**
3. Would you consider a proposal some monetization solutions (for your benefit) to be implemented through the proposed app, which could require on a second phase local activities? **The City is open to all innovative solutions and the successful bidder will have an opportunity to present any and all ideas during the negotiation phase of the process.**
4. Our solution could thus indirectly create local work opportunities, which could be managed by the Dept. of Economic Inclusion. **See answer to question 2.**

5. Will the City grant access to the data, as noted in the RFP's scope of services, and its topology? TANK & SORTA are available through GTFS and Red Bike is available through GBFS. At this time, the City will only be hosting the parking data and is currently working to make this available on the Open Data portal.

6. In reference to the City's 20 page limit for proposals, would the City please confirm that "one page" would be defined as double sided and includes both the front and back of a sheet of paper? A page is defined as one side of a sheet of paper.
