

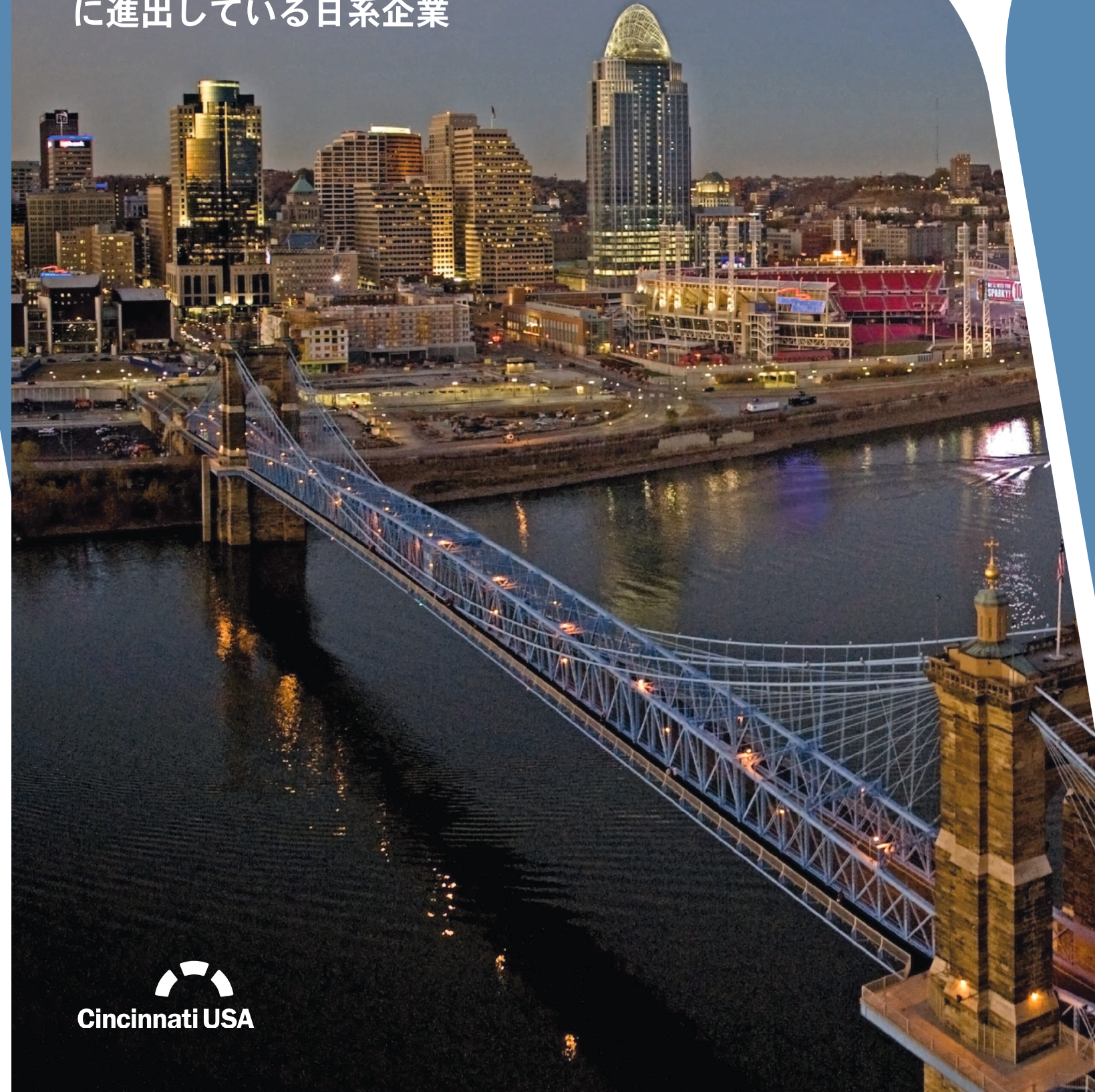
Cincinnati USA Japanese Investment Companies

Local Japanese Community

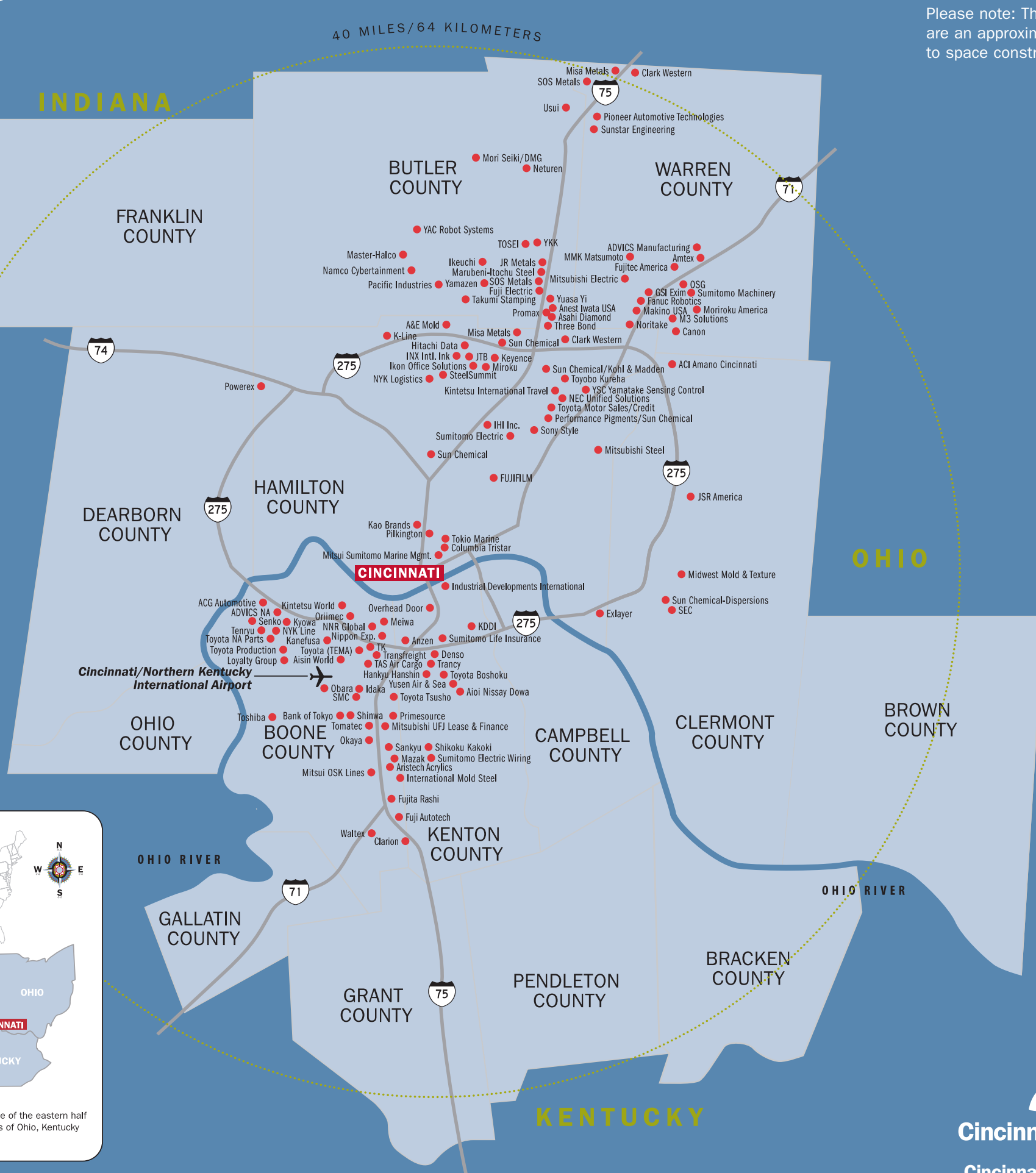
The **Japan America Society of Greater Cincinnati (JASGC)** is a non-profit organization created more than 20 years ago to promote a better understanding and cultural awareness between the people of Japan and the people of Cincinnati USA. Its diverse range of business, cultural and education-oriented programs enables JASGC to enrich the lives of its members and the community at large.



The **Japanese Language School of Greater Cincinnati** was established in 1975 by a small group of parents who wanted their children to learn Japanese. Today, the school is housed on the campus of Northern Kentucky University and is one of the largest of its kind in the Midwest, with approximately 400 students enrolled.
